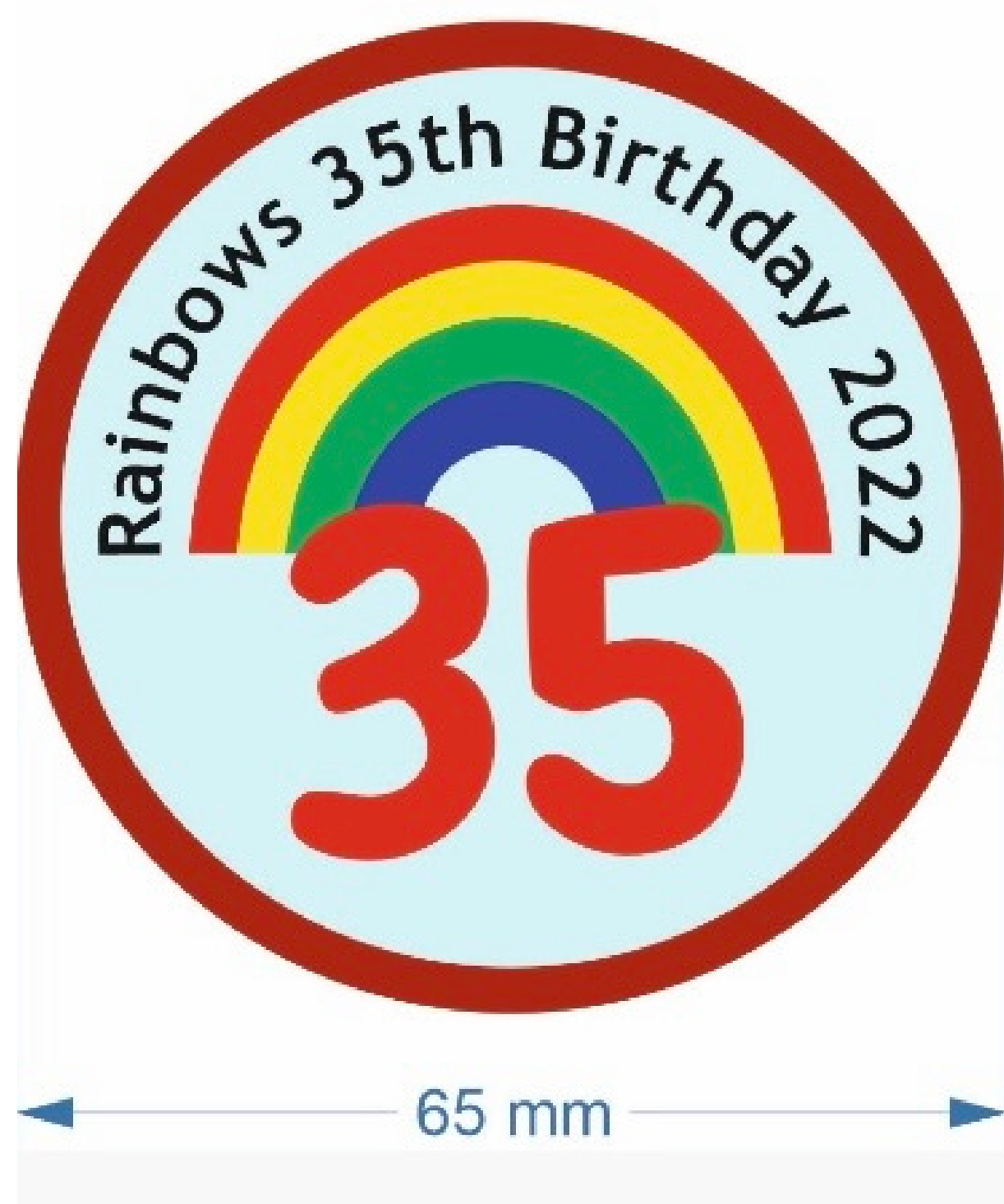


Rainbows 35th challenge badge



Supporting 1st
Papworth Brownies
and Rainbows units



This challenge badge is suitable for all ages. It can be completed at home, in a guiding or scouting unit or on a camp/sleepover. All money raised from this badge and pack will go to 1st Papworth Rainbows in Cambridgeshire.

Rainbows (age 4-7) = 4 challenges
Brownies (age 7-10) = 5 challenges
Guides (age 10-14) = 6 challenges
Rangers (age 14-18) = 7 challenges
Adults = 8 challenges

Leaders can receive a badge for helping the unit complete the challenges.

This badge has been created to enjoy everything about Rainbows and parties whilst at home or in the unit as a celebration.

RAINBOWS 35th BIRTHDAY BADGE

Celebrating 35

- Do a good deed everyday for 35 days. Keep a record of what you do.
- Sew 35 badges onto your camp blanket.
- Create a playlist of your favourite 35 songs, artists or albums.
- Write a diary for 35 days
- Run, swim or cycle 3.5 miles
- Stick 35 chocolate discs onto your face! Have a race with someone and see who can do it quickest.
- Create a time capsule and hide it for 35 years. What will you add? How old will you be when you need to find it?
- Look up the cost of items from 35 years ago. How much was a loaf of bread? How about a house?
- Go on a litter pick and collect 35 bits of rubbish (make sure an adult helps you, wear gloves and be mindful of broken glass)
- Find a picture of what Rainbows wore 35 years ago. How has it changed?
- Go on a 35 minute walk. Explore somewhere you've never walked before
- Declutter your bedroom/house. Can you find 35 items you no longer need that you could then donate to a local charity shop?

Celebrating Rainbows

- Make a rainbow out of Hama Beads
- Complete the skittles science experiment. Place some skittles in a circle on a plate and then pour some water or milk into the middle of the circle. Watch the rainbow appear. See resources
- Send a birthday card to a Rainbow unit
- Richard Of York Gave Battle In Vain is a great way to remember the colours of the rainbow. Can you make up another one?
- Make rainbow cookies by adding coloured chocolate beans to a cookie recipe. See resources
- Paint the colours of a rainbow onto one end of some kitchen roll. Place that end in a cup of water and the other end into an empty cup. Watch the rainbow move across the kitchen roll. See resources.
- June is pride month. Colour in your own pride flag.
- Tie dye an old white T-shirt or tote bag. See resources
- Take a photo of the next rainbow you see.
- Make yourself a rainbow salad (or fruit salad).
- Make a friendship bracelet from different coloured threads!
- Go on a Rainbow treasure hunt and find an object for each colour of the rainbow.

Celebrate with a party

- Learn how to create a balloon arch. Can you use different coloured balloons to create a rainbow arch?
- Design and create some bunting for your party.
- Make a birthday card for a friend or relative
- What would be in your dream party bag? Party bags aren't very big but what would you love to find inside? Swap ideas with a friend
- Design and create invites for your party.
- If you could invite 7 famous people to your party, who would you choose and why.
- Learn how to make a balloon animal and show a friend
- Be a party designer. Design your dream birthday party. Where would it be held? What theme would it be? And what would you do?
- Make a birthday in a box! Include a present, a card, a cake, balloons and banners.
- Learn the song Happy Birthday in Makaton
- Make party food. Will it be sausage rolls? Or jam tarts?
- Make you're party as green as possible. What aspects can you re-use? Which parts can be recycled.
